The entry criterion for the MYP Program is the completion of Grade 5 primary school.

In the Middle Years Programme, students take courses in the following subject areas: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics, Design, Physical Education, and The Arts. In grade 9&10, students also have the opportunity to work on a personal project and a community project.

The course hours for each subject are standardized at 50 hours per year. However, note that students may take additional courses or explore additional extracurricular activities as part of their personal learning journeys.

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
